1. No cell phones during service

We have determined a specific standard of dress for all attendees, including leaders. With all of us working together to uphold this standard, we hope to maintain a focus on what truly matters. - No revealing or excessively tight clothing
- Legging must be worn with t-shirts, not short tops
- No offensive slogan or profanity on clothing or hats
- Shorts should be appropriate length
- No sagging pants or shorts
- No spaghetti strap tops (all straps should be an inch or two finger tips wide)
- No crop tops
- Skirts/Dresses must be 3 inch above the knee or longer
- No clothing revealing the stomach, bra, or back
- Girls: One piece bathing suit (with shorts) or dark cover ups when swimming
- Guys: Athletic shorts are not considered swimsuits. Shirts must be worn at all times, except when swimming
